

With an abundance of natural resources and a stable industry base, South West Queensland is a major hub for the energy and resource sector. The region has a significant oil and gas resource as well as one of the South West is one of the largest producers of opal in the world.

The hydro power plant in Thargomindah was the first in Australia and the third in the world, with the region's renewable power journey starting in 1893. Today, the region remains at the cutting edge of clean and renewable energy, including deployment of solar, waste heat recovery, renewable methane trials and carbon capture and storage (CCS) technology.

APA Group is currently conducting a \$2.2 million trial of a new hydrogen technology at Wallumbilla.
